PRIMA INDUSTRIE AWARDED AT INTERNATIONAL LEVEL FOR THE TECHNOLOGICAL INNOVATION Major awards for the company from Turin which was awarded at the International Business Awards 2016 and received a special mention at the Premio Eccellenze d'Impresa GEA -(Harvard Business Review) 2016

Collegno - October 24th, 2016 - The ability to innovate and develop leading edge products brings three awards at Prima Industrie, leader in the developing, manufacturing and marketing of laser systems and sheet metal machinery and industrial electronics for industrial applications. The Group was in fact awarded at the 13th International Business Awards, and received a special mention during the delivery of the Premi Eccellenze d'Impresa (Corporate Excellence Awards) GEA-HBR 2016.

During the 13th International Business Awards the company was named the winner of a Silver Stevie® Award in the "Company of the year - Electronics - Medium size" category and a Bronze Stevie® Award in the "Most innovative company of the year - in Europe" category.

The International Business Awards are the world's premier business awards program. All individuals and organizations worldwide - public and private, for-profit and non-profit, large and small - are eligible to submit nominations. The 2016 IBAs received entries from more than 60 nations and territories. In particular this year a record total of 3,800 nominations from organizations of all sizes and in virtually every industry were submitted this year for consideration in a wide range of categories.

Nicknamed the "Stevies["] for the Greek word for "crowned," the awards have been presented to winners at a gala awards banquet at the Rome Cavalieri Waldorf Astoria Hotel in Rome, Italy on 21 October.

As for the "Company of the year - Electronics - Medium size" award, that was received by Mr. Federico Ziliani (VP of the subsidiary Prima Electro, operating in the field of industrial electronics and laser sources) during the ceremony of last October 21st, the judges recognized the talents of Prima Group for great product innovation and the ability of the company and management to understand fully the market requirements, combining innovation and technology, features that will enable the company to have a sustainable and profitable growth for a long time.

The company was also congratulated for being the first in the sector to come up with its own fiber laser technology. The award for the "Most innovative company of the year - in Europe", delivered to Mrs. Chiara Roncolini (Investor Relations Manager and legal affairs), was in fact assigned by the jury in order to award a team of highly capable people with excellent market insights and an organization whose R&D investments represent 6.5% of turnover; such investments allowed the company to introduce to the market in the last few years technologically advanced new products.
